1. Qualifications:

- University degree or currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree program
- Valid Police Record Check, Standard First Aid and CPR level C
- Tutoring experience
- Ontario Teacher Certification an asset
- Interest in teaching, tutoring, and assisting students to succeed academically
- Bilingualism an asset
- Ability to tutor math and sciences an asset

2. General Responsibilities:

- To tutor children from grades 1 – 12 in a variety of academic subjects
- Communicate any problems to Academic Centre Coordinator and appropriate Manager
